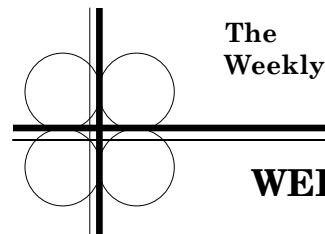

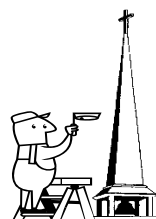

COFFEE & JUICE FELLOWSHIP is held between Sunday worship services in the Main Lobby. This month's host is the Council on Children's Ministries.

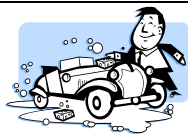
