

## **PASTORS PAGE**

Dear Saints with Strangely Warmed Hearts,

May 24, 1738 is an important date for Methodists. It marks the spiritual awakening that occurred within John Wesley as he attended a prayer meeting on Aldersgate Street in London during the evening. Charles Wesley, John's brother, had an experience the day before while in his sick bed. It was this experience which led to his writing "Where Shall My Wondering Soul Begin" (UMH #342).

John Wesley's experience is regarded as the beginning of the Methodist movement. His own account of the experience serves to best describe what happened:

"In the afternoon I was asked to go to St.
Paul's Cathedral. The anthem was, 'Out of the deep have I called unto thee, O Lord'... In the evening I went very unwillingly to a society in Aldersgate Street, where one was reading Luther's preface to the Epistle to the Romans. About a quarter before nine, while he was describing the change which God works in the heart through faith in Christ, I felt my heart strangely warmed. I felt I did trust in Christ, Christ alone for salvation: And an assurance was given me, that he had taken away my sins, even mine, and saved me from the law of sin and death."

Brothers and sisters, may we remember John Wesley's words of assurance. I pray your heart will be strangely warmed as we gather together in faith.

You equip IJM teams to rescue girls and young women who were forced into the darkest corners of the modern sex trade, and you help them achieve God-given dignity and peace through restorative aftercare programs. Even more, you are helping build a future where all girls will be safe from this horrific abuse.

Your prayers and support were crucial for our team in Mumbai in 2018. Last year, you sent us to free dozens of victims from brothels, hotels and private homes where they were being sold for sex. Together we built the capacity of local law enforcement to protect the poor even without IJM's help, and we innovated new ways to help survivors access justice in their own communities with confidence again.

## Our impact together in Mumbai, India:



#### **RESCUE**

We partnered with authorities to rescue **21** girls and young women from sex trafficking.



#### **RESTORE**

Our aftercare programs helped restore **17** survivors to health and wholeness.



#### **RESTRAIN**

We made sure **14** pimps, traffickers and other criminals were held accountable.



#### REPAIR

We trained **2,800** police, judges, church members and other leaders to combat slavery.


