Over the past three years our congregation was able to accomplish a major feat by paying off our mortgage. As we move forward from our Breaking Free campaign, we have begun to see improvement in our general giving. First quarter 2014 compared to first quarter 2013 shows an \$11,000 increase! Praise God and thank you for your generosity.

Lamentably, in 2013 we experienced a drop in our general giving which led us to use our line of credit in order to make payroll, and to maintain general operating expense. As part of our agreement with our bank it is necessary to zero out our line of credit for a period of thirty days annually. In order to complete this transaction, and upon the advice of our accountant and Senior Pastor, the Church Council and the Trustees have agreed to transfer \$22,000 from the building fund account to general funds for a period of no more than 36 days to fulfill our obligation to the bank, effective July 1, 2014. On August 6, 2014 the funds will be transferred back to the building fund.

We believe that it is important to communicate this decision for the sake of transparency. We know that we can count on you to reduce our need for this line of credit in the coming year. As we move forward, we pray that this will give Trinity the ability to establish a solid financial base so that we may to continue to provide to the spiritual and physical needs of our congregation, community, and the world. Thank you again for your faithfulness.
