Last Sunday Trinity members and visitors signed up for 28 half-hour prayer times and contributed \$485 for Bibles and other costs for Kairos Inside #21 at MD Correctional Institution, Hagerstown. Please continue praying for the residents (inmates) and the team as they complete the weekend this afternoon.

Last weekend at KI #4 at MCI Jessup, 6 deaf or hearing impaired residents participated. They were at one table with an interpreter and represented the first time in Maryland that the hearing impaired were included in a weekend.

Of course, prayer for Kairos is welcome any time, and volunteers are critically needed as this ministry expands. The first weekend at MD Correctional Training Center, Hagerstown, will be held next June, making the sixth prison in Maryland to host a Kairos weekend. Hundreds of men and women have been touched by the Holy Spirit through it and increasingly, wardens are asking for Kairos to be started as they see the changed behavior and transformed lives that result from introducing residents to the love of Jesus.
