The first weekend at MD Correctional Training Center, Hagerstown, will be held next June, making the sixth prison in Maryland to host a Kairos weekend. Hundreds of men and women have been touched by the Holy Spirit through it and increasingly, wardens are asking for Kairos to be started as they see the changed behavior and transformed lives that result from introducing residents to the love of Jesus.


