ALZHEIMER'S AWARENESS

Wandering is a common behavior associated with the disease. Six out of 10 people with dementia wander and may not be able to recall their name or address. The Alzheimer's Association offers safety services and education programs to help promote home safety and reunification with loved ones.

- A history of either high blood pressure or high cholesterol doubles one's risk of developing Alzheimer's; those with both are 4 times more likely to develop dementia
- The risk of Alzheimer's disease increases after the age of 65 and age is the greatest risk factor to developing the disease
- It is the only leading cause of death in the top 10 that cannot be prevented cured, or even slowed.
