Our most recent data from January to May shows great improvement from the same time last year. Giving income is up for this period by over \$21,000 or 11.5%; all this while expenses are only up by 1% overall. There is still a deficit and we still struggle to pay our apportionments, but this is a marked and blessed improvement over the same period last year.

This is wonderful news and we praise God for your generosity and faithfulness in giving to God’s work at Trinity.

In other news, we received our report on June 18 from consultant Dustin Cooper and the Team will begin implementing Dustin’s recommendations. Additionally, the Stewardship and Finance Team will focus on the Annual Fall Pledge Campaign that we will initiate this year and henceforth. It has

been many years since Trinity has had a formal Annual Pledge Campaign and we look forward to its success. This will be an every member campaign for regular church offering income, a time for us to take notice of all the ways we have been blessed by God. When we notice God working in our everyday lives, our gratitude will create a more generous heart. We are encouraged to recognize daily blessings and recognize God as the source. This will be a time for us to make a grateful pledge to the work of Trinity for the next year, 2016.
