

FROM THE TRINITY PASTORAL COUNELING CENTER

February is the **love month.** Not only just because of Valentine's Day, but also because it has become a month for focusing on love in relationships. Our faith encourages us to roll up our sleeves and dig a little deeper in connecting through **love-agape.**

People often think of couples therapy when they are in crisis or when there is much suffering. However, did you know that therapists are trained to think more broadly about two people in counseling? The term "dyad" – this simply means two people in a relationship – is part of their training. Most people do not realize that therapy can include working with divorced couples seeking to co-parent better. Other dyad relationships might include parent-adult child, siblings, or even friends, neighbors, or co-workers – any two people - who want to work on their relationship.



Think for a minute of every person in your relationship circles. Is there a relationship that would benefit from learning more skillful ways of communicating and listening? Maybe there has been a bump in the road and a misunderstanding resulted? Perhaps there is someone you would like to work with on a specific problem? Maybe you know of others who would benefit from growing their relationship skills.

If we measure our love in care and attention to each other, then maybe this is an opportunity for you to grow in awareness of all the love that is around you.


