Provide organ and piano accompaniment at regular and special services of the church. 2. Provide organ and piano accompaniment for funerals and weddings in consultation with the pastor. 3. Accompany the Chancel Choir on a regular basis at all rehearsals and performances. 5. Accompany all Youth and Children's Choirs on an "as needed" basis. 6. Provide accompaniment for special musicians, as needed. 7.
