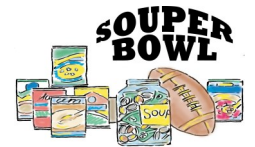

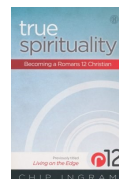
UNITED METHODIST COMMISSION ON RELIEF (UMCOR) CONTAINERS

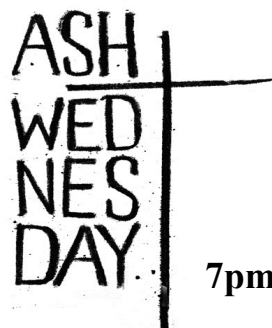
