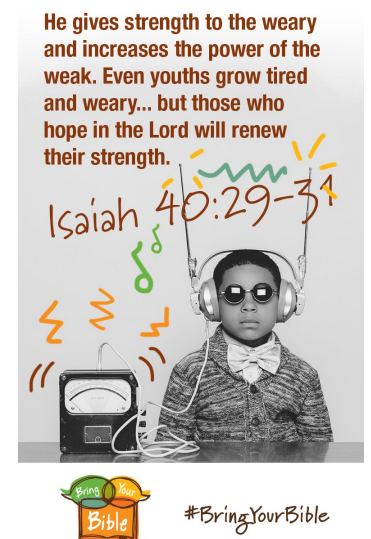

***Could You Be a Barnabas?***

*Joseph, a Levite from Cyprus, whom the apostles called Barnabas (which means Son of Encouragement), sold a field he owned and brought the money and put it at the apostles’ feet” (Acts 4:32-37).*

Barnabas was a man of God who saw the apostles' financial need as they spread the Gospel. Mission needs money, so Barnabas sold some property he owned to help extend God's kingdom. That wasn't the extent of his ministry, however, for we later read about his missionary journeys with Paul and then with John Mark. He must have completed other acts of stewardship for he isn't known by his given name, Joseph, but was nicknamed Barnabas for his gift of giving encouragement to others.

*This was an all-around guy. Some of us think that, if we give money, we're off the hook when it comes to serving on committees which could use our expertise. Others of us may say our finances are pretty tough, so, instead of giving, we'll teach Sunday School or sing in the choir. We make choices that limit God. God doesn't ask us to give what we don't have; He does ask each of us to give according to our abilities. Unless we have no income at all, we can give an offering. All of us can find some way to use our time and talents to serve the people God loves, and our Church.*

Our giving in response to God's grace in our lives can serve to encourage others just as Barnabas has throughout the ages.
