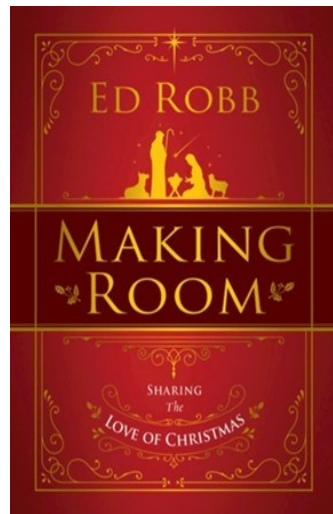

ADVENT IS COMING... Nov. 29 - Dec. 24

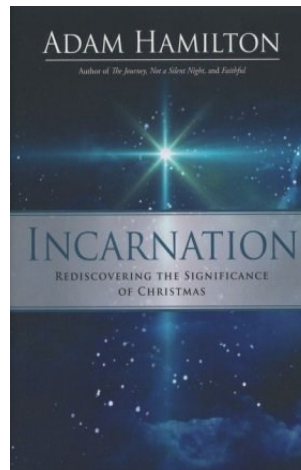
