

Reclaiming the name Lincoln

Saturday, February 20th at 7 pm

Please come and join us on Saturday, February 20th at 7pm via Zoom for one of our two conversations about Black History during this month.

For this presentation, we will have *The African American Resources, Cultural Heritage Society* (AARCH) of Frederick County. This organization has been committed to preserving and sharing the history and heritage of the African American community in Frederick.

Come and join us for a special presentation by AARCH's President, Mr. David Key. Mr. Key will lead us on a conversation regarding the struggle our African American brothers and sisters in Frederick had to endure in order to reclaim the name Lincoln for one of our elementary schools. We will watch the video "Reclaiming the Name Lincoln," which was produced by AARCH in order to help our children and the Frederick community learn about our

A conversation on the intersectionality between African American rights, women's rights, and LGBTQ+'s rights.

Saturday, February 27th at 7 pm

This is the story of Pauli Murray, a report from Democracy Now on the documentary titled "My Name Is Pauli Murray" (36 minutes video). The report addresses how the Rev. Dr. Pauli Murray is one of the most ignored, yet, pivotal figures in the struggle for racial and gender equality in the 20th century. Rev. Murray's work influenced the likes of Ruth Bader Ginsburg and Thurgood Marshall.

This report features excerpts from "My Name is Pauli Murray," which features new footage and audio recordings of Murray in her own words, and interviews about Murray with Ruth Bader Ginsburg (RBG) and Bishop Michael Curry, the Presiding Bishop of The Episcopal Church. The report is a conversation with the filmmaking team behind the documentary, director Betsy West and producer Julie Cohen. This is a powerful story on the history of yet another Saint of the Church - Dr. Pauli Murray has been canonized as a saint by the Episcopal Church (See: <https://today.duke.edu/2012/07/saintmurray>).
