June is National PTSD Awareness Month. Historically, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) symptoms were documented as far back as the treatments. Civil War in the United States, but goes back millennia in the world. During WW I, WW II and the Korean treatment, the War, some soldiers experienced what was called in the past shell shock, soldier's heart, combat fatigue or war neurosis. After the

Vietnam War, PTSD came to be named and recognized formally in the mental health diagnostic manual in 1980.

Trauma work has extended beyond military trauma and now includes anything that causes symptoms from one or more events that are disturbing to the person. Symptoms can include poor sleep, nightmares, emotionally numb, hypervigilant, poor concentration, jumpy, irritable, loss of interest in things that used to be fun, flashbacks, increased substance use, heart racing when triggered by a memory or situation reminiscent of the bad memory.

Our center specializes in trauma-informed Ideally, the sooner the sooner healing can take place to



reduce symptoms. We encourage anyone who suspects PTSD-like disruptions to seek help. Newer therapies exist that help people get symptom relief.
