ACM 2021: Together for Joy

October is our Annual Commitment to Ministry! Annually, we take a look at our practice of faith in community. What spiritual practices do we need to pick up? What do we need to set down? How can we connect best with our bodies, souls, and minds with God? What new song do we need to sing for a new season in our lives? But the world has seemed so heavy. Church life in some ways due to changes because of the pandemic has seemed so heavy. We didn't want the Annual Commitment to Ministry to feel like a chore. We wanted it to be a gift.

The theme this year is "Together for Joy!" Staying together through the delights and struggles of life - being "together for joy" - has never been more important. And while change brings financial challenges in its wake, it also

brings fresh opportunities to sing to God a new song, for God has done - and will do - marvelous things. I've already experienced some of those marvelous things with you already, even though I've only been here a few months. Hearing a little about the Appalachia Service Project trip, the beginning of hybrid Grow Time, youth group starting up again, so many beautiful flower arrangements and musical numbers, and all your prayers when we had our accident. Even those of you I have not met in person have made us feel together, part of this Trinity family.

But the world doesn't do the togetherness thing very well right now. Everything feels so fractured. We argue about politics. We argue about public health. We argue sometimes just to hear our own voices. And challenging each other is important. Standing up for what's right is important. But let's not allow our arguments to keep us from coming together in Christian love, and even sometimes in joy! In Psalm 98, the Psalm that this campaign is based on, all of creation comes together to make a joyful noise!

Because "for joy" is the second part of the title for our annual commitment to ministry. Again, the world right now seems not to be a joyful place. Our brains are wired to see the negative out of a biological sense of self-protection, but there's a lot happening in the world that can be upsetting. What if, together, we didn't just pay attention to the joy that is around us but we also helped one another experience joy through our prayers for one another, our presence in worship (online or in person), our gifts of talent or finances, our service in mission, and our witness to the love of God in our lives?

You will be getting letters and even a devotional booklet written by Trinity members about what brings them joy. I invite you into prayer over Psalm 98 and the ways that you can join with our Trinity family together for joy!




What You Believe Drives Everything

A WOW item: doll, soccer ball with pump, stuffed animal, an outfit of clothing

Hygiene items: soap and washcloth, toothbrush, comb, brush

Clothing and accessories: shirt, pants, socks, flip flops, hat, sunglasses, scarf, mittens

Toys: doll, car/truck/boat, puzzle, ball, slinky, etch-a-sketch, finger puppets, yoyo, blocks, play dough,

crayons, coloring book, game

School supplies: pens, pencils, sharpener, eraser, notebook, glue stick (no liquid), markers,







