<p>GENERAL PURPOSE OF POSITION: To work in concert with the senior pastor and staff in order to "Make disciples for Jesus Christ, transform the community and world."</p> <p>ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES</p> <p>Job Description: The Music Director shall be a person with a mature Christian faith who is committed to Christ, and who will facilitate a positive worship experience through the selection and/or performance of appropriate sacred music that correlates with the theme of the service and who will assist the various choirs and special musicians of the church by providing accompaniment.</p> <p>Responsibilities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide organ and piano accompaniment at regular Sunday and special services (Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, Christmas Eve and others noted on the calendar) of the church. 2. Coordinate the music and arts for the worship services throughout the year, including scheduling Trinity Brass, Take Note, choirs, praise music, and soloists to perform regularly in worship. 3. Provide organ and piano accompaniment for funerals and weddings in consultation with the pastor. Musician will be paid by family requesting these services. 4. Accompany the Chancel Choir on a regular basis at all rehearsals and performances. Rehearsals are currently Wednesdays at 7:15pm- 8:45 p.m. 5. Accompany all Youth and Children's Choirs on an "as needed" basis. 6. Provide accompaniment for special musicians, as needed. 7. Meet with the Pastor on a regular basis to assist in the musical growth of the congregation. 8. Prepare and oversee the music budget. 9. Prepare appropriate publicity and information for the monthly and weekly <i>Cloverleaf</i> (church-wide newsletter), the church web page, and other media outlets as necessary. 10. Work with the trustees to oversee the maintenance and/or repair of the musical instruments of the church in consultation with the organist and other instrumentalists. 11. If leave is requested, it is the responsibility of the musician to secure a substitute musician if at all possible. (To include as much notice as possible.) <p>Benefits:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 12. Annual Paid Vacation includes 4 Sundays (and weekly practices) a year after completion of a probationary period of 90 days. 13. Sick and unpaid leave can be arranged with the senior pastor and the SPRC. <p>Supervision:</p>			

- Supervised by the Senior Pastor, or a person assigned by the Senior Pastor.

Qualities preferred:

- Sensitivity and flexibility to the flow of worship in the service
- Good knowledge of Christian music
- High level of comfort with performing a wide variety of Christian musical styles
- An appreciation of and demonstrated involvement in the field of music and arts
- Additional preference may be given to individuals with a degree in music
- Organization and good communication with the rest of the music and worship team.
