In whatever way you labor, may you have a restful holiday reflecting on the promises of the Lord:

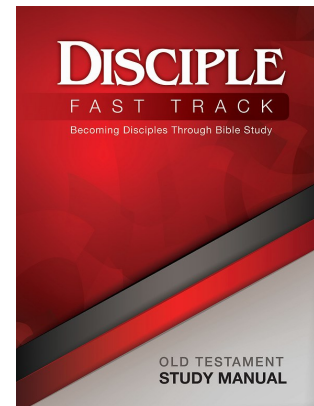
