Volunteers will also be needed to help distribute 50lb. bags to local non-profit organizations such as food banks, rescue missions, homeless shelters and churches with outreach ministries coming for pick-up. If your church or non-profit organization would

like to deliver potatoes to their communities, 50-pound bags are available for free. Reservations will close Tuesday, March 21<sup>st</sup> at 6pm. Please arrive between 9:00am-10:30am on Sat., March 25<sup>th</sup> at the church parking lot to pick up your potatoes. ### Here are the various ways and opportunities you can help volunteer

- Baggers - to bag up smaller bags of potatoes
- Loaders - to help load of the 50 pound bags for people outside
- Counters - to count the number of small bags inside the MPR and separate for pick up
- Stackers - teens to stack 50 pound bags on tables for people to break open and make smaller 10 pound bags
- Delivery Drivers - people who can take deliveries to Senior Housing places and drop off small bags to them in one room
- Cleanup - a team that will help cleanup the MPR once done
