We are grateful to all who supported our trip:

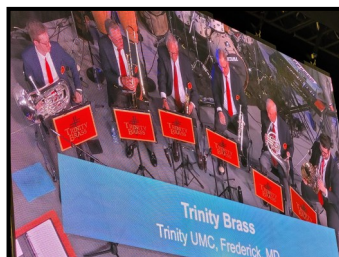
- * The TUMC members who donated money to cover our expenses;
