<p><b>GENERAL PURPOSE OF POSITION:</b> To work in concert with the senior pastor and staff in order to "Make disciples for Jesus Christ, transform the community and world."</p> <p><b>ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES</b></p> <p><b>Job Description:</b> The Organist/Accompanist shall be a person of faith or respectful of people of faith, and who will facilitate a positive worship experience through the selection and/or performance of appropriate sacred music that correlates with the theme of the service and who will assist the various choirs and special musicians of the church by providing accompaniment.</p> <p><b>Responsibilities:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Provide organ and piano accompaniment at regular Sunday and special services (Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, Christmas Eve and others noted on the calendar) of the church.</li> <li>2. Provide titles and copyright information for all Prelude/Postlude/Offertory selections to the Coordinator of Music and church office at least 6 days before the worship service.</li> <li>3. Provide organ and piano accompaniment for funerals and weddings in consultation with the pastor. Musician will be paid by family requesting these services.</li> <li>4. Accompany the Chancel Choir on a regular basis at all rehearsals and performances. Rehearsals are currently Wednesdays from 6:00 - 7:30 p.m.</li> <li>5. Accompany all Youth and Children's Choirs on an "as needed" basis.</li> <li>6. Provide accompaniment for special musicians, as needed.</li> <li>7. Meet with the Coordinator of Music and Arts or designee on a regular basis to assist in the musical growth of the congregation.</li> <li>8. If leave is requested, it is the responsibility of the musician to give as much notice as possible and secure a substitute musician. Suggestions for substitutes will be provided.</li> </ol> <p><b>Additional responsibilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attend Music Department meetings as scheduled.</li> </ul> <p><b>Benefits:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Annual Paid Vacation includes 4 Sundays (and weekly practices) a year after completion of a probationary period of 90 days.</li> <li>• Sick and unpaid leave can be arranged with the senior pastor and the One Board.</li> </ul> <p><b>Supervision:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supervised by the Senior Pastor, or a person assigned by the Senior Pastor.</li> </ul> <p><b>Qualities preferred:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Promptness and preparedness for all rehearsal and services</li> </ul>
